Aerial sports (paragliding, delta plane, etc.)

Certain areas of the Gruyère Pays-d'Enhaut Regional Nature Park are more vulnerable than others. Special rules therefore apply, particularly on aerial sports. Please comply with the relevant rules and regulations and adapt your behaviour accordingly.

Legal restrictions (see map overleaf)

Green hatched areas: Vanil Noir and La Pierreuse nature reserves

> Flying at low altitudes is not permitted – the regulations of the two reserves prohibit overflying at low alltitude.

Brown areas: Federal game reserves

➤ Take-off and landing ban: the ordinance on federal game reserves prohibits the take-off and landing of manned civilian aircraft.
